Opening for a student's scholarship at the Center for Theoretical Physics PAS

We invite applications for an undergraduate student's scholarship at the CTP PAS, financed from the SONATA BIS project entitled "Characterization and certification of quantum resources" (2019/34/E/ST2/00369). The project leader is **dr hab.** Remigiusz Augusiak (website: http://raugusiak.weebly.com/).

We are looking for talented **student of physics or mathematics** with a good background in theoretical physics (or mathematics), in particular in quantum physics. The subject of the project is widely-understood verification and certification of quantum resources. The aim of the internship is to familiarize with the subject of the project and then to do research on one of the problems specified by the project leader.

Scholarship: 1500 PLN/month

Duration: 6 months

The candidates should submit the following documents:

- 1. Curriculum vitae including the course of studies and possible scientific achievements (publications, participation in research projects, conferences, etc.).
- 2. Agreement for processing the data for the purpose of recruitment procedures (enclosed below).
- 3. Possible recommendation letter.

Submissions are to be received electronically (only pdf files) at the email rekrutacja@cft.edu.pl by the closing date of October 4, 2024. In your e-mail's subject please add the reference number: RA/19/2024.

The winner will be selected by **October 11, 2024**. Proposals will be assessed in accordance with the guidelines imposed by the National Science Centre:

Information clause - scholarship competition

- 3. your personal data will be processed in connection with participation in the scholarship competition, and in case of winning the competition, in connection with receiving the scholarship on the basis of your consent Article 6(1)(a) of the RODO.
- 4. your personal data will be processed for a period of 6 months after the end of the scholarship competition, and in the case of receiving a scholarship for a period resulting from legal and tax regulations;
- 5. your personal data will be made available to other entities that may finance and settle the scholarship, entities conducting research projects and entities authorized under the law. Access to your data will be granted only to persons authorized by the administrator;
- 6. Providing personal data by you is obligatory, if you do not provide them you will not be able to participate in the scholarship competition;
- 7. You have the right to access the content of your data, the right to correct them and limit the processing;
